



OFFICE ORDER

The Board in its 133rd meeting held on 26/10/2006, while discussing the matter regarding shifting of industries from non-designated areas to the designated areas, has taken a serious view about the industries which, though, are operating in the designated areas but are not properly operating their pollution control devices and also have made substantial expansions creating problem to the existing infrastructure available in the designated area. The Board, therefore, desired that to ensure regular operation of pollution control devices, the industries be directed to:

1. Provide separate energy meters on their pollution control devices.
2. Maintain chemical register showing the consumption of chemicals for running the pollution control devices.
3. Provide manhole outside the premises of the industry for collection of sample of the trade effluent without entering the industry.
4. Direct the industry to stick to original capacity for which the infrastructure such as CETP/Sewerage grid etc. are designed and in case the industry wants to enhance the capacity over and above the designed capacity, it would be required to take care of the additional quantity of the effluent, itself without damaging the existing infrastructure.

All the industries discharging their effluent should be directed to comply with the above decisions of the Board.
